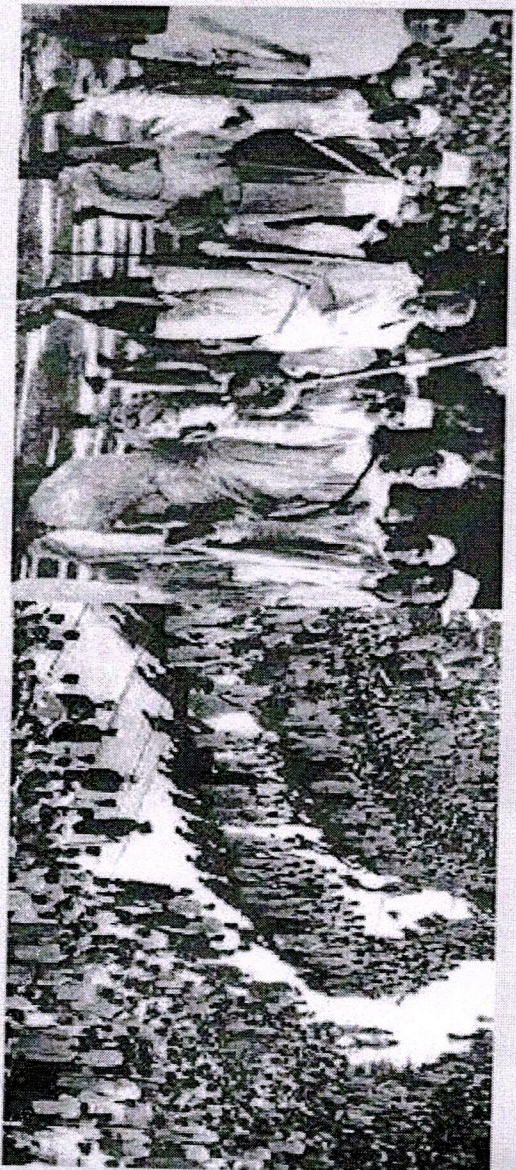

The Department of History organized a seminar to commemorate the glorious occasion of the platinum jubilee celebration of the Quit India Movement of 1942. The movement was launched by the Father of the Nation Mahatma Gandhi on 9th August 1942, demanding an end to the British rule in India and then on 15th August 1947 India became independent. The occasion was a milestone in the history of India's freedom struggle - a heroic struggle of the Indian people, students, peasants, women, workers and government officials who defied the brutal repression of the British Raj to launch mass struggle that shook the very foundation of the British rule.

## **OBJECTIVE :**

The major objective of the seminar was to provide a pen portrait of the sequence of events and its relevance in the modern day context. Apart from being a syllabus oriented talk it also aimed at illuminating the young minds about the rich heritage of the country.

The lecture was delivered by Dr. Arabinda Shit, Assistant Professor, Department of History, Chandraketugarh Shahidullah Smriti Mahavidyalaya, Berachampa, North 24-Parganas. It was extremely informative and thought provoking colourful panoramic presentation.

## **PARTICIPATION :**

Seventy - six students and fifteen teachers including the Teacher-in-Charge Dr. Ishani Ghosh were present there.

## **OUTCOME :**

The seminar apart from helping the students to have a clear picture and understanding of the particular historical event also trained the youth of today to fight against such social evils as poverty, corruption, terrorism, casteism, malnutrition and thereby ushering the dawn of New India.
